The mayor's decision is not an act of censorship, but of moral coherence. It sends a clear message: freedom and democracy do have defenders within Mexico's public institutions—beyond ideologies or party affiliations.

We call on other local governments to follow this example and to reassess the use of public space, ensuring it is not used to promote regimes like those of Cuba, Venezuela, or Nicaragua—governments that have been denounced by international human rights organizations for systematic abuses.

At a time when the continent is torn between liberty and servitude, Mexico Republicano reaffirms its commitment to the cause of those who resist communism and continue the struggle for a Mexico free from all complicity with dictatorships.
