Mexico City, July 6, 2025

Solidarity with the People of Texas Amid the Flood Emergency

The overflow of multiple rivers—including the Brazos, Trinity, and Colorado—caused by torrential rains in recent days, has triggered a serious emergency across various regions of the state of Texas. Over 50 counties have been declared disaster zones, and it is estimated that at least 40,000 people have been evacuated due to severe flooding that has damaged homes, roads, schools, and hospitals.

México Republicano expresses its deepest solidarity with the people of Texas in the face of this climate tragedy, which is impacting tens of thousands of families—including a significant number of Mexicans, Mexican Americans, and descendants of our binational community residing in Houston, Dallas, San Antonio, Austin, and other affected areas.

Our organization calls upon Mexican society, both in Mexico and the United States, as well as all members and supporters of the *México Republicano* movement, to join efforts and take immediate humanitarian action.

Cooperation between sister nations is most clearly demonstrated in times of adversity. Therefore, we call for the mobilization of donations, food, medical supplies, and logistical resources, in coordination with local authorities, civil society organizations, and relief networks already active in Texas.
