



Statement from *México Republicano*

***México Republicano* calls on the Federal Government to take urgent action to contain the crisis currently affecting the national automotive industry.**

Mexico City, November 1, 2025

Mexico's automotive industry—a strategic pillar of our economy and a source of hundreds of thousands of direct and indirect jobs—is facing an unprecedented crisis. In recent months, several plants have temporarily halted production, and some, such as the COMPAS plant in Aguascalientes, have announced permanent closures. These decisions put at risk billions of dollars in foreign investment, concentrated mainly in states such as the State of Mexico, Guanajuato, Puebla, and Aguascalientes.

Among the factors exacerbating the situation are:

- Operational pauses at key plants, including Stellantis in Toluca, General Motors in Silao, and Audi in Puebla.
- A potential loss of investment estimated at approximately USD 6 billion, excluding the broader impact on suppliers and associated jobs.
- A high concentration of investment in a few states, increasing vulnerability to market adjustments or external policy changes.

México Republicano considers these warnings to be clear alarm signals for the national economy. The absence of immediate action could result in an irreversible loss of competitiveness, employment, and international credibility.

We urge the Government of Mexico, led by President Claudia Sheinbaum, to:

1. Guarantee the stability and operational continuity of automotive plants and their supply chains.
2. Implement stimulus and protection measures to ensure the permanence of foreign direct investment in the country.
3. Prioritize coordination with productive sectors and local authorities to prevent any risk of closure or relocation of strategic plants.

The automotive industry is not only a source of employment but also a pillar of innovation, technology, and global competitiveness for Mexico. *México Republicano* reiterates that immediate government action is essential to protect investment, jobs, and international confidence.
