



## Statement from *México Republicano*

***México Republicano* expresses its deep concern over the ongoing institutional deterioration and the recent warnings issued by the international financial sector regarding the rule of law in our country.**

Various authoritative voices—including global business and financial leaders—have raised alarms about the impact that the loss of judicial independence, fiscal arbitrariness, and the weakening of regulatory bodies are having on international confidence in Mexico.

In recent days, analysts such as José Mario have precisely summarized the shared diagnosis across multiple sectors: *“Mexican justice has become a political instrument,”* a statement that reflects an alarming perception of institutional vulnerability.

*México Republicano* believes that these observations should not be dismissed as attacks, but rather regarded as legitimate warnings that the Federal Government, led by President Claudia Sheinbaum, must heed with seriousness and a sense of urgency. Economic stability, investment, and the well-being of millions of Mexican families depend on an autonomous judiciary, a predictable fiscal framework, and independent regulators that ensure legal certainty and transparency.

We call on the Government of Mexico to take concrete steps to restore global confidence in our institutions: to strengthen the independence of the Judiciary, end political pressure, and guarantee impartiality in the administration of justice.
